What is SSC GD Constable?

Staff Selection Commission-General Duty-Constable (SSC GD Constable) is a national-level recruitment exam conducted by Staff Selection Commission. The exam is conducted to recruit candidates for the posts of Constable (General Duty) in Border Security Force (BSF), Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), Indo Tibetan Border Police (ITBP), Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB), National Investigation Agency (NIA), Secretariat Security Force (SSF) and Rifleman (General Duty) in Assam Rifles.

SSC GD Constable Vacancies

SSC GD Constable vacancies in NIA and SSF are filled on all-India basis whereas vacancies in all other CAPFs are filled as per the vacancies available in various states/UTs. Besides, the vacancies that are earmarked for the Border Guarding Districts and Militancy/Naxal affected Districts are reserved for the candidates of these districts only. Last year, a total of 60,210 vacancies were announced.

SSC GD Eligibility 2020

Various parameters that candidates need to fulfill in order to meet SSC GD Constable eligibility are:

- **Nationality** – Candidates must be citizens of India
- **Age Limit** – Candidates should be aged between 18 and 23 years. The upper age limit is relaxable for candidates belonging to SC, ST, OBC, Ex-Servicemen and other categories as given below:

Categories	SSC GD Constable Age Relaxations
Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)	5 years
Other Backward Class (OBC)	3 years
Ex-Servicemen (ESM)	3 years after deduction of the military service rendered from the actual age as on the date of reckoning
Children and dependents of victims killed in the 1984 riots or communal riots of 2002 in Gujarat (Unreserved)	5 years
Children and dependents of victims killed in the 1984 riots or communal riots of 2002 in Gujarat (OBC)	8 years
Children and dependents of victims killed in the 1984 riots or communal riots of 2002 in Gujarat (SC/ST)	10 years
Candidates who had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from January 1, 1980 to December 31, 1989	5 years

- **Educational Qualification** – Candidates must have passed Class 10 from a recognised board. Candidates appearing for their qualifying examination (Class 10) are not eligible for the exam

SSC GD Constable Selection Process

SSC GD selection process consists of Computer-Based Examination (CBE), Physical Efficiency Test (PET), Physical Standard Test (PST) and medical examination. The complete steps of the selection process are as explained below:

Step 1: SSC GD application form

The first and foremost step of the recruitment process is filling SSC GD constable application form. Candidates need to fill the application form online on the official website of SSC. The application fee for all candidates is Rs 100 (women/SC/ST/ex-servicemen candidates are exempted from fee payment).

Step 2: SSC GD admit card

SSC GD Constable admit card is issued at least two to three weeks before the exam. The admit card is made available online. Candidates need to download the SSC GD Constable admit card 2019 from the official website by entering the required login credentials. The admit cards for PET/PST and DME/RME are uploaded by CRPF.

Step 3: SSC GD exam

All candidates whose online applications are accepted are called to appear in the CBE. The test carries 100 objective-type questions of 100 marks.



The question paper is divided into four parts - General Intelligence and Reasoning, General Knowledge and General Awareness, Elementary Mathematics and English/Hindi. The difficulty level of questions are of matriculation level.

Step 4: SSC GD result

SSC GD constable 2019 result is declared online separately for each stage of exam. The result is made available online in PDF format on the official website of SSC.

Step 5: SSC GD PET/PST

Based on the performance of CBE, candidates are shortlisted for PET and PST. The tests are conducted at various centres finalized by the CAPFs.

Step 6: SSC GD medical examination (DME)

Candidates qualifying the PET/PST exam finally need to appear for the medical examination. Post this exam, male and female candidates are allocated forces separately based on their aggregate scores.

SSC GD Constable 2020 Exam Day Guidelines

Some of the important exam day guidelines that candidates must keep in mind are:

- Candidates must bring their [SSC GD Constable admit card](#) to the exam centre
- Candidates must carry a photo-identity proof like Driving Licence, Voter Card, Aadhaar Card, Identity Card issued by University/ College, Income Tax Pan Card, etc in original
- Electronic gadgets are not allowed inside the examination centre
- Candidates must reach the exam centre on time
- Candidates reaching the exam centre late are not allowed to appear in the exam

SSC GD Constable 2020 FAQs

Q: How many stages does SSC GD Constable exam contain?

A: The SSC GD exam contains four stages - Computer-Based Examination (CBE), Physical Efficiency Test (PET), Physical Standard Test (PST) and medical examination.

Q: Is there any age limit to appear for SSC GD exam?

A: Yes, candidates should be 18-23 years of age in order to be eligible for the exam.

Q: How many times is SSC GD conducted in a year?

A: Each stage of SSC GD Constable exam is typically conducted once a year.

Q: How many vacancies are released for recruitment through SSC GD exam?

A: Over 50,000 vacancies are released for recruitment through SSC GD exam. In 2018, total 60,210 vacancies were released for constable posts in different departments.

Q: What is the application fee for SSC GD exam?

A: Candidates need to pay Rs 100 as application fee for the exam. Women of all categories and SC/ST/ex-servicemen candidates are exempted from application fee payment.

Q: What is the minimum eligibility criteria for the exam?

A: Candidates should be class X pass in order to be eligible for the exam.

Q. What is the salary of SSC GD Constable?

A. Candidates after selection are entitled to a salary of Rs 21,700 to Rs 69,100.

Q. What is the qualification for SSC GD Constable recruitment?

A. Candidates must have completed matriculation/class 10.

Q. What is the qualifying cut off for CBE?

A. The cut off marks of CBE is 35% for General and Ex-Servicemen and 33% for SC/ST/OBC.

Q. How many candidates are shortlisted for PET/PST?

A. The number of candidates shortlisted for PET/PST on the basis of merit in CBE will be 10 times the number of vacancies.

Q. How the final allocation of candidates is done?

A. The final allocation of candidates is done based on the performance of candidates in the CBE, PST, PET and Medical Examination are qualifying in nature.

Admit Card

SSC GD admit card 2020 for **Detailed Medical Examination (DME)** has been **released**. All shortlisted candidates can download the SSC GD Constable admit card from the official website of Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF). The SSC GD DME 2020 will be conducted for 1,723 qualified candidates from March 26 to April 7.

The hard copy of the admit card will not be sent to candidates by post.

How to download SSC GD Constable Admit Card for DME?

Candidates can follow the below-mentioned steps to download the admit card for SSC GD exam:

- Visit the official website of CRPF - crpf.gov.in
- Click on the Recruitment tab available at the bottom of the page
- Click on the SSC GD DME admit card link
- Click on the Candidate Login button
- Enter username, password and captcha code visible on the screen
- Download the admit card and take its printout

Documents to carry along with SSC GD Constable Admit Card

Candidates must carry at least one of the following photo identity proofs – Driving Licence, Voter Card, Aadhaar Card, Identity Card issued by University/ College, Income Tax Pan Card, etc in original to the CBE, PST/PET, DME/RME centre.

What if I am unable to download SSC GD Constable admit card?

If any candidate does not find their detail regarding the admit card for CBE on the official website one week before the exam, they must immediately contact the concerned regional or sub regional office with the proof of having submitted [SSC GD Constable application form](#).

In case of inability to download the admit cards for PST/PET and DME from the website of CRPF, candidates must contact the authority at least one week before the exam. The CRPF recruitment helpline number is 011-24368630. Candidates must write their registration number or roll number, name, date of birth and exam name.

SSC GD Constable Admit Card: Important Points

- The admit cards are available online only
- Candidates must bring at least two passport-sized photographs for affixing it in the Commission's copy of admit card in the presence of the



invigilators

- Candidates not carrying photographs will not be allowed to appear in the exam
- Without photo-identity proofs, candidates will not be allowed to appear for the exam
- SSC GD Constable admit card for any stage are not be sent by post
- Facility to download the admit cars is provided at the regional websites of Commission as well as on the CRPF website

Phases of SSC GD Constable Admit Card

The admit card of SSC GD Constable will be issued in three stages – CBE, PST/PET and DME. The details of each stage is explained below –

SSC GD Constable Admit Card for CBE

The admit card for CBE is issued to all candidates whose applications are found to be eligible for the recruitment exam.

SSC GD Constable Admit Card for PET/PST

The call letters for PET/PST is issued to candidates qualifying the CBE. The admit card for this stage is issued online by CRPF. The detailed programme for PET/PST is uploaded on the official website of CRPF at least two weeks before the exam.

SSC GD Constable Admit Card for DME

Candidates qualifying the PST/PET are issued admit card for DME. SSC GD Constable admit card for this stage is also released by CRPF.

Dates

SSC GD Constable 2020 Dates

Staff Selection Commission (SSC) will soon announce SSC GD Constable dates 2020. The dates are usually announced along with the notification. SSC GD Constable dates comprises the complete schedule of the exam. It includes the dates of important exam events like application, admit card, result, answer key, cutoff etc. Candidates must keep themselves updated with SSC GD constable dates so that they do not miss any event. As the dates of SSC GD Constable have not been released yet, we have provided below the tentative months of the exam events.

The events mentioned above are explained below in detail –

SSC GD Constable 2020 Application Form

Candidates need to fill [SSC GD Constable application form 2020](#) online. To apply for SSC GD Constable, candidates need to first register for the exam by filling their basic details. After generation of registration ID and password, candidates will be able to fill the detailed application form. The application fees is Rs 100 (Women/SC/ST/Ex-Servicemen candidates are exempted from fee payment).

SSC GD Constable Admit Card 2020

[SSC GD Constable admit card](#) for CBE is released by SSC two or three weeks before the exam. The admit card is made available online on the regional websites of SSC. Candidates need to download the same from the region from where they have applied for the exam. Admit cards for PET/PST and DME/RME will be uploaded by CRPF.

SSC GD Constable 20120 Exam

The recruitment process of [SSC GD Constable](#) comprises CBE, PET, PST and Medical Exam. All those candidates who successfully applies for the exam are required to appear for CBE. The CBE comprises of one objective type paper containing 100 questions of 100 marks. In PET/PST candidates will be assessed based on their height parameters.

SSC GD Constable 2020 Result

The result of SSC GD Constable is announced online. Candidates need to visit the official website to check their result. SSC GD Constable result will be available in PDF format. The result will display roll number, category and name of candidates.



Application Form

SSC GD constable application form is released online by Staff Selection Commission (SSC). The application form comprises two parts - Part-I (registration) and Part-II (application form). While filling SSC CGL application form, candidates need to pay the required fees which is Rs 100 (women/SC/ST/ex-servicemen candidates are exempted from fee payment).

Pre-requisites for filling SSC GD Constable Application form

Candidates should keep the following documents ready for filling SSC GD Constable application form.

- Bank details to make online payment
- Class 10 marksheet and admit card
- Aadhaar Card or Aadhaar Enrollment number
- In case candidates do have Aadhaar Card or Aadhaar enrollment number can enter details of their Voter ID Card, PAN, Passport, Driving License, School/College ID and Employer ID
- Scanned image of photograph and signature
- Left-hand Thumb Impression (LTI) in JPEG format

How to fill SSC GD Constable Application Form 2020?

To fill SSC GD Constable application form 2019, candidates need to follow the procedure given below.

SSC GD Constable Registration

- For one time SSC GD Constable registration 2019, candidates need to click on 'Register Now' link in the home page
- During SSC GD Constable 2019 registration, candidates need to fill the basic details, additional details, contact details, photo signature and LTI
- Provide information about Aadhaar number/Aadhaar enrollment number/identity card and its number
- Candidates need to fill their name as given in Class 10 certificate
- Fill in father's and mother's name as given in Class 10 certificate
- Candidates are also required to fill their date of birth as given in Class 10 certificate
- Candidates need to fill details of their Class 10 exam during SSC GD Constable registration which includes – name of education board, roll number and year of passing
- Enter gender, highest educational qualification, mobile number, email ID etc
- After filling the basic details, candidates need to confirm their mobile number and email ID.
- On confirming, registration ID and password will be sent to candidate's registered mobile number and email ID.
- Candidates can proceed towards filling the 'Additional Details' by clicking Next button
- Candidates need to fill Category, Nationality, Identification Mark, Temporary and Permanent Address
- Upload photograph and signature, Aadhaar Number or Aadhaar
- Enrolment Number, Left Thumb Impression etc
- Upon clicking the 'Final Submit' different OTPs will be sent to candidate's registered mobile number and email ID.
- Candidates need to enter the OTPs to complete the registration process
- After submission of basic information, if the registration process of is not completed within 7 days, the data will be deleted from the system



- After completion of registration process, basic details can be changed only once

Part II – Online SSC GD Constable Application Form 2020

- Candidates need to login into their account through registered email ID and password
- Candidates can change the password when asked to do the same
- Click 'Apply' link in [SSC GD Constable](#) section under 'Latest Notifications' tab
- Information filled during SSC GD Constable 2019 registration will be auto-filled and are non-editable
- Candidates need to enter their preferences of exam centres. They can choose three exam centres in the order of preference
- Select Domicile State/ UT and District of Domicile
- Candidates need to give preference of CAPFs/ Organizations
- Candidates need to enter their highest qualification
- Information regarding photo/signature/biometric impression is filled automatically from one time SSC GD Constable registration data
- Candidates should pay the application fee online or SBI Challan
- Candidates need to complete their application process by clicking on 'I Agree' check box and fill the captcha code
- Take printout of SSC GD Constable 2019 application form for further reference

SSC GD Constable Application Fees

The application fee is Rs 100. However, women, SC, ST/Ex-Servicemen candidates are exempted from fee payment.

Specifications for photograph, signature and LTI

- The scanned photograph should be between 20 to 50 kb
- The signature should be in JPEG format between 10 to 20kb
- The LTI should be in JPEG format between 10kb to 30kb
- The disability certificate should be in JPEG/PDF format between 20kb to 50kb

SSC GD Constable Application Form FAQs

Q. Is SSC GD Constable registration mandatory for applying to the exam?

A. Yes, one-time registration is necessary before filling the application form.

Q. I am unable to upload my signature and photograph. What should I do?

A. Check the size and format of the signature and photograph files.

Q. I did not receive registration number and password on my email. What to do?

A. You can check the 'Spam' folder or contact the helplines of the concerned regional office.

Q. How to get the password and registration number if candidates forgets it?

A. Candidates need to go to the 'Forgot Password' link and enter the required details. On verification, the registered email ID and registration number will be displayed on the screen. Candidates will be prompted to change the password. Set the password and keep it safely.

Q. I have made payment more than once. How to get refund?

A. Fee once paid will not be refunded.

Q. I have paid the fee through challan. Do I need to enter my transaction ID and date of deposit in the application form?

A. No, candidates need to wait for two to three working days. The payment details will be updated automatically.

Q. What to do if the application status is showing incomplete after making online payment?

A. It means the fee is not received by the commission from the bank. Status of payment can be verified through 'Payment Status' or 'Double Verification of Payment' links.

Q. Will I be allowed to make changes in the details after final submission?

A. No, candidates will not be allowed to make changes in the details after final submission.

Q: Is Aadhaar card mandatory to apply for SSC GD exam?

A: No, candidates can provide details of any ID proof at the time of filling the application form.

Q: Can I pay SSC GD application fee in offline mode?

A: Yes, you can pay the fee in offline mode through SBI challan.

Q: What is the minimum qualification required to apply for the exam?

A: Candidates should have passed class X from a recognised board.

Pattern

SSC GD constable pattern is prescribed by Staff Selection Commission (SSC) separately for Computer Based Examination, Physical Efficiency Test



(PET) and Physical Standard Test (PST). SSC GD Constable pattern provide details regarding the overall structure of exam like number of sections, total marks, exam duration, marking scheme. Candidates can check below the detailed SSC GD Constable exam pattern 2020.

SSC GD Constable Pattern 2020 for Computer Based Test (CBT)

The CBT paper of [SSC GD Constable](#) will consist of one objective type paper of 100 marks. The test will have total 100 questions. The language of the question paper will be in English and Hindi. The duration of the test is 90 minutes. The structure of CBT is given below –

SSC GD Constable Exam Pattern for PET & PST

Based on the performance in CBT, candidates are shortlisted for PET/PST by SSC. During PET/ PST, candidates are assed on height parameters. Those qualifying the same will have to undergo PET (race) followed by biometric/ technology aided identification.

General Intelligence & Reasoning

Questions in this section are basically asked from analogies, similarities and differences, spatial visualization, spatial orientation, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non- verbal series, coding and decoding, etc.

General Knowledge and General Awareness

This section aims to test a candidate's general awareness. Questions are designed to test candidate's knowledge of current events.

Elementary Mathematics

This paper will include questions on Number Systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between Numbers, Fundamental arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, Mensuration, Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and Work, etc.

English/ Hindi: Candidates' ability to understand basic English/ Hindi and comprehension are tested.

Syllabus

Staff Selection Commission (SSC) prescribes SSC GD Constable syllabus. The syllabus of SSC GD constable comprises topics under General Intelligence & Reasoning, General Knowledge and General Awareness, Elementary Mathematics and English/Hindi.
