Selected candidates are required to pursue one year Post Graduate Diploma in Banking and Finance (PGDBF) course at Indian Bank Manipal School of Banking (IBMSB), jointly set up by Indian Bank and Manipal Global Education Service Pvt Ltd. On successful completion of the course, candidates will be appointed to the post of PO.

Candidates having a degree in any discipline can apply for Indian Bank PO recruitment. Candidates can check below the detailed eligibility criteria.

Indian Bank PO Recruitment 2020 Selection Process

The selection process of Indian Bank PO comprises three stages, Preliminary, Mains and Interview. The complete selection procedure is explained below:

Submit the application form

Applications will be accepted in online mode only. To fill Indian Bank PO application form 2019, candidates need to keep documents like scanned photograph and signature, bank card details, email ID etc. Candidates need to register for the exam by entering their basic details. After generation of registration number and password, candidates need to login to fill the detailed application form. The application fee can be paid online which is Rs 100 for SC/ST/PWD candidates and Rs 600 for others.

Release of admit card

Indian Bank PO 2019 admit card for preliminary, mains and personal interview will be issued to all eligible candidates online only. Candidates can download their admit by entering registration number and password/date of birth. No hard copy of the admit card will be sent to candidates by post.

Appear for the preliminary exam

The online preliminary exam comprises three sections - English Language, Quantitative Aptitude and Reasoning Ability. The test paper will have total 100 questions. Maximum marks allotted for the test is 100.

Appear for the mains exam

Candidates will be selected for the mains exam based on their scores of preliminary exam. The mains exam comprises four objective type papers and one descriptive paper. Total marks of the test is 225. There is sectional timings in mains exam.

Appear for the Interview

The interview will be conducted for 100 marks. The minimum qualifying marks in interview is 40% for General and 35% for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates.

Declaration of Result

The result for all the stages is announced online. The roll numbers of shortlisted candidates will be made available in PDF. Candidates can check their marks by logging with registration number/roll number and date of birth.

Indian Bank PO Exam Centres 2020

The prelims exam of Indian Bank PO will be conducted in over 100 cities. The mains exam will be held in 50 cities. Candidates are required to choose the exam centres while filling the application form. [Read More](#)

A. The starting salary of Indian Bank PO is Rs 23700. The payscale is 23700-980/7-30560-1145/2-32850-1310/7-42020.

A. Candidates need to fill the application form online for Indian Bank PO recruitment.

A. All the selected candidates will have to undergo one year of post-graduate diploma in banking and finance (PGDBF) at Indian Bank Manipal School of Banking (IBMSB), Bangalore. After completing the course, they are appointed as Probationary Officer in JMG-I post.

Q. How can I select the exam centre?

A. Candidates can select the exam centre while filling the application form.

Q. Is there any number of attempts in the exam?

A. No, there is no limit in the number of attempts.

Q. How can I download the admit card?

A. [Indian Bank PO admit card](#) is released online separately for different stages of recruitment.

Q. I am from the science stream. Can I apply for the exam?

A. Yes, you can apply for the exam.

Q. I have 65% in graduation with MBA and didn't have proficiency in appropriate computer skills am eligible or not?

How to fill Indian Bank PO Application Form 2020?

The steps to fill the application form of [Indian Bank PO 2020](#) are given below:

Indian Bank PO Registration

- Candidates need to visit the careers page of Indian Bank.
- Click the link 'Recruitment of Probationary Officers Through on Boarding'.
- Click on 'Apply Online for PO On Boarding'.
- Candidates should click on 'New Registration' tab to register their application.
- Enter the basic details to complete the registration process.
- Once the data is filled, click on 'Submit' button.
- On successful registration, registration number and password will be generated.

Uploading of Photograph and Signature

- Candidates need to upload their scanned images of photograph and signature as per the given specifications.
- The dimension of the photograph should be between 200 x 230 pixels. The size of the file should be between 20kb to 50 kb.
- The dimension of the signature should be between 140 x 60 pixels. The file size should be between 10kb to 20kb.

Filling the detailed application form

- After uploading the photograph and signature, candidates need to fill Indian Bank PO application form 2020 in details.
- Candidates need to enter their educational qualification
- Choose the exam city for appearing in the preliminary and mains exam
- Agree to the declaration and submit the application form

Application fee payment

The application fee is Rs 100 for SC/ST/PWD categories and Rs 600 for general category. Fee can be paid using debit cards, credit cards, internet banking, IMPS, cash cards/mobile wallets. On successful completion of the transaction, an e-receipt will be generated.

Pattern

Selection of candidates through Indian Bank PO recruitment is done based on preliminary and mains exam followed by interview. Indian Bank PO exam pattern is prescribed by the examination authority. The exam pattern of preliminary exam is divided into three sections - English Language, Quantitative Aptitude and Reasoning Ability. The mains exam according to Indian Bank PO exam pattern is a mix of both objective and descriptive type test. The detailed exam pattern of Indian Bank PO recruitment is given below.



Indian Bank PO Exam Pattern 2020 - Preliminary Exam

All the questions in the test will be objective type. The language of the paper will be both in English and Hindi. Duration of the test is 1 hour. The question paper will have total 100 questions. Total marks allotted to the test are 100. Candidates need to qualify in each of the three tests by securing the minimum cut off marks. Adequate number of candidates in each category will be shortlisted for online main exam.

Indian Bank PO Exam Pattern 2020 - Mains Exam

Questions in the mains exam will be asked from Reasoning & Computer Aptitude, General/ Economy/Banking Awareness, English Language, Data Analysis & Interpretation. The descriptive type test will have questions from English Language (Letter Writing & Essay). There will be total 155 objective type questions and carries 100 marks. Candidates will be given 3 hours to solve questions from objective type test and there will be sectional timings. The descriptive test will have total 2 questions and maximum marks allotted to the test are 25. Duration of the test is 30 minutes.

Indian Bank PO 2020 Marking Scheme

There is penalty for wrong answers for objective tests. For each question, 1/4 marks or 0.25 marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty for wrong answers. If a question is left blank there is no penalty for that question.

Indian Bank PO Exam Pattern 2020 - Interview

The interview is conducted for the qualified candidates of mains exam. The total marks allotted for Interview are 100. The



minimum qualifying marks in interview is 40% for General and 35% for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates.

Syllabus

Indian Bank PO syllabus 2020 is divided into preliminary and mains exam. The syllabus of preliminary exam comprises topics from English Language, Quantitative Aptitude and Reasoning Ability. Section-wise cut off: The examination authority calculates this cut off out of the marks allotted to individual sections.

Overall cut off: The cut off is calculated out of the total marks of the exam.

The objective type test comprises four sections, Reasoning & Computer Aptitude, General/ Economy/Banking Awareness, English Language and Data Analysis & Interpretation. The descriptive test comprises English Language (Letter Writing & Essay). The cutoff of mains exam is calculated out of 225 marks. The score of prelims exam is calculated out of 100 marks. For correct answer, one mark is awarded to candidates while 0.25 marks are deducted for the wrong answer. Candidates need to qualify in each section by securing the minimum cut off marks. Adequate number of candidates in each category will be shortlisted for online main exam.

Indian Bank PO Mains Result:

The marks of mains exam are calculated out of 125 marks. One-Fourth marks are deducted for wrong answers in the mains exam. The pdf file contains the registration number, roll number, name, interview centre, date of interview and reporting time. Candidates qualifying the mains exam are called for Personal Interview.



Indian Bank PO Interview:

The interview is conducted for the qualified candidates of mains exam. The Interview carries a total of 100 marks. The minimum qualifying marks in interview are 40% for General and 35% for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates.

Indian Bank PO Final Result:

The final result of Indian Bank PO is declared based on the marks of mains and interview. The weightage that will be given to mains and interview will be 80:20. A category-wise merit list will be prepared for all the qualified candidates.

What after the declaration of Indian Bank PO result?

All the selected candidates will have to undergo one year of post-graduate diploma in banking and finance (PGDBF) at Indian Bank Manipal School of Banking (IBMSB), Bangalore. After completing the course, candidates will be appointed as Probationary Officer in JMG-I post.

Vacancies

Indian Bank PO 2020 vacancies will be released along with the notification. The examination authority releases the vacancies category-wise. Candidates against these vacancies are selected based on preliminary exam, mains exam and interview. In 2018, a total of 417 vacancies were released. Read below for more details on Indian Bank PO vacancies.

Important points related to Indian Bank PO Vacancies

- The reservation for Persons with Disabilities (PWD) is provided on a horizontal basis.
- The selected candidate will be placed in the appropriate category such as SC/ST/OBC/UR to which they belong.
- The number of vacancies of [Indian Bank PO](#) are provisional and vary according to the actual requirement of the bank.

Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities

Under Section 34 of The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, persons with benchmark disabilities are eligible for Reservation. The following categories are eligible for reservation.

Blindness and low vision

Deaf and hard of hearing

Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy



Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness

Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under the above-mentioned categories including deaf-blindness in the posts identified for each disability

Indian Bank PO Selection Process

Candidates are selected based on the following stages:

Preliminary exam:

This is the first stage of the selection process. The test comprises three sections-English Language, Quantitative Aptitude and Reasoning Ability. The test carries total 100 questions. Total marks of the test are 100. Candidates qualifying the exam are called for the mains exam.

Mains exam:

The mains exam is conducted for the shortlisted candidates of prelims exam. The objective type test comprises four sections, Reasoning & Computer Aptitude, General/ Economy/Banking Awareness, English Language and Data Analysis & Interpretation. The descriptive test comprises English Language (Letter Writing & Essay). Total marks of the mains exam is 125.

Interview:

The interview is conducted for the shortlisted candidates of the mains exam. The test carries total 100 marks. The minimum qualifying marks in interview is 40% for General and 35% for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates. Final selection of candidates are done based on mains exam and interview. The weightage given to mains exam and interview is 80:20.
