LIC AAO 2020 Eligibility Criteria

The candidates must ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility conditions before appearing in the LIC AAO exam. The eligibility conditions are the minimum conditions which need to be achieved by the candidates.

LIC AAO 2020 Age Limit

As per the official notification, the date mentioned for age calculations is March 1 of the exam year. The candidate must have attained the age of 21 and must not exceed the age of 30 years. (The candidates must have been born not earlier than 02.03.1990 and not later than 01.03.1999 both days inclusive). Following age relaxation is provided to the reserved category candidates:

Educational Qualification required for LIC AAO

Since there are functionally different positions notified under the umbrella exam of LIC AAO, the educational qualifications required for all the posts are different. Following are the required post-wise required educational qualification:

A. For AAO (Generalist): Graduation degree in any discipline.

B. For AAO (IT): Bachelors degree in Engineering in Computer Science, IT or Electronics, or an MCA, or an MSc(Computer Science).

C. For AAO (Chartered Accountant): Bachelor's degree from a recognised Indian University/Institution and candidate should have passed the final examination of Institute of Chartered Accountants of India and completion of articles as presented by Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

The candidate should be Associate member of Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Candidates need to provide their membership number and it will be verified with Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

D. For AAO (Actuarial): Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognized Indian University/Institution and Candidates should have compulsorily passed paper CT 1 and CT 5 plus 4 or more other papers of the examination conducted by the Institute of Actuaries of India / Institute and Faculty of Actuaries, UK. (Total 6 or more papers) as on the date of eligibility i.e. March 1, 2020.

Candidates should provide their membership number and the same will be verified with Institute of Actuaries of India / Institute and Faculty of Actuaries, UK.

E. For AAO (Rajbhasha): Post Graduate Master's Degree in Hindi/Hindi translation with English as one of the subjects at Bachelor's Degree level or

Post Graduate Master's Degree in English with Hindi as one of the subjects at Bachelor's degree level

or

Post Graduate Master's Degree in Sanskrit with English and Hindi as subjects at Bachelor's degree level.

All the educational qualifications mentioned should be obtained from a University/Institute/ Board recognised by Govt. of India / approved by the Government Regulatory Bodies and the result should have been declared on or before March 1, 2020. It implies that the candidates appearing in the last year of their graduation degree are not eligible to appear in the LIC AAO exam.

LIC AAO Syllabus

The selection in the LIC AAO exam is only possible when the candidates prepared the LIC AAO syllabus very well and the candidates after preparation do well in the exam. The candidates can get the topics and details about the [LIC AAO Syllabus](#) here.

LIC AAO Selection Process

The LIC AAO exam is conducted in three stages. Following are the stages in the LIC AAO exam:

- Preliminary Examination
- Main Exam
- Interview



In addition to the above, the Pre-Recruitment Medical examination is also a part of the selection process.

LIC AAO Guarantee Bond

The candidates who clear the LIC AAO exam in all means will be appointed as Probationer for one year. This period can be extended to two years based on the performance of the candidate. Before joining as a Probationer in the LIC, the candidate needs to furnish a guarantee bond of 2 lakh rupees. The candidate will have to submit Deed of Indemnity at his/her cost, duly stamped, the stamp value of which will be as applicable to the State in which the deed is executed by the candidate.

LIC AAO FAQs

Q. Is there any negative marking in the LIC AAO Exam?

A. There is no negative marking at any stage of LIC AAO exam. The LIC AAO notification 2020 does not mention about negative marking or penalty for the wrong answer.

Q. What is the difference between LIC AAO and LIC ADO?

A. LIC Assistant Administrative Officer is very different from LIC Apprentice Development Officer. ADO work under the Divisional officers and help in building the business through recruitment of LIC agents under them.

Q. Is there any normalisation of marks in LIC AAO exam?

A. Yes, there are normalisation of marks in the LIC AAO prelims as well as mains exam. The process is explained in the notification.

Q. Can a candidate apply for more than one post?

A. No, the candidate cannot apply for more than one post. In case the candidate applies for more than one post, his/her form gets rejected.

Q. Is there any group discussion in the LIC AAO interview?

A. There is no group discussion in the LIC AAO interview. No such group exercise is mentioned in the LIC AAO notification.

Q. Is LIC AAO a target based job?

A. No, LIC AAO is not a target based job. It is an administrative job and the candidates need to manage the back-office operations.

Q. Is LIC AAO a government job?

A. Life Insurance Corporation of India is a state-run insurance company. It is one of the largest PSU in India.

Q. When will be LIC Notification released?

A. The LIC AAO Notification was released on February 25, 2020.

Q. Is LIC AAO a rural job?

A. It depends on the posting because LIC has the offices in each nook and corner of the country. But the offices will not be located in purely rural areas.

Q. Is LIC AAO a field job?

A. No, LIC Assistant Administrative Officer is not a field job. It is an office job but sometimes the officer needs to travel for audit, supervision and the likes.

Q. Is there any Guarantee Bond in LIC AAO?

A. Yes, there is a Guarantee Bond of Rs Five Lakh as given in the LIC AAO notification 2020.

Syllabus

LIC AAO exam 2020 is postponed due to the coronavirus outbreak in the country. Life Insurance Corporation (LIC) conducts the Assistant Administrative Officer (AAO) Exam each year for various posts including the following.

- AAO (CA)
- AAO (Actuarial)
- AAO (Legal)
- AAO (Rajbhasha)
- AAO (IT)
- AAO (Generalist)

There are no vacancies of AAO (Generalist) this year. The candidates can only apply for the specialist vacancies in case they fulfil all the eligibility criteria for the post. Before diving deep into the LIC AAO syllabus, it is better to discuss the [LIC AAO exam pattern](#).

LIC AAO Syllabus 2020: Reasoning Ability



The test of reasoning ability is designed to test the objectivity of the candidates. This section tests the reasoning power of the candidates, which will be helpful while doing the job in a real-time situation. The LIC AAO syllabus of Reasoning Ability is similar for the prelims and main exam because the topics are not defined in the [LIC AAO notification 2020](#). The only difference is the level of difficulty of questions in the prelims and main exam. The LIC Syllabus does not provide details about the topics of the tests. The candidates need to prepare each topic in its entirety so they can attempt any question.

In the prelims, the reasoning ability questions are relatively simple compared to the main exam. They can be easily solved within the time limit, but the questions of the main exam are relatively difficult. The candidates need to prepare more intensely for the LIC AAO prelims exam because it acts as a filter exam in the LIC AAO recruitment process.

LIC AAO Syllabus 2020: Quantitative Aptitude

Quantitative Aptitude is another important section in the LIC AAO syllabus. The candidates are tested for their calculation, accuracy and speed. The candidates need to practice the questions based on the quantitative aptitude topics so they can answer accurately. Besides accuracy, speed is the other important factor which is the deciding in the final selection. For both factors, practice is the only key.

LIC AAO syllabus for the prelims and the main exam is similar and the topics are not mentioned or explained in the notification. The candidates need to prepare all the topics for prelims. This will be a good strategy because it will help in the main exam as well.

LIC AAO Syllabus 2020: General Knowledge, Current Affairs

General knowledge and current affairs section is only asked in the LIC AAO main exam. This can be the toughest section in the LIC AAO exam because of its enormity. General knowledge is more concerned about past events. Current affairs, on the contrary, are more concerned with the news of current times. It involves the factual and analytical orientation of current events. For the candidates of the [LIC AAO exam](#), this section is the deciding factor for the final selection because none of the topics is fixed. Even from the topics, different questions can be framed.

General knowledge and current affairs section is the most complex sections amongst all. The candidates need to prepare this section very thoroughly to avoid any confusion at the time of paper. The topics for the LIC AAO exam for the General Knowledge and Current Affairs can



include the following

LIC AAO Syllabus 2020: English

English section is qualifying only in the LIC AAO prelims exam. There are 30 objective questions in the LIC AAO prelims exam, which is essential to qualify. Though its number is not counted in the LIC AAO merit list it is important because the selection depends upon its qualification.

The English syllabus for the LIC AAO exam is as follows

In the main exam, the candidates need to qualify the English descriptive test of 25 marks. Though qualifying only, the English section plays a very important role because it is mandatory to secure the minimum qualifying marks. If the candidate secure high marks in the other sections and does not qualify the English section, then he will not be qualified for the LIC AAO posts.

LIC AAO Syllabus 2020: Insurance & Financial Market Awareness

Insurance and financial market awareness are very important for the LIC AAO main exam because it shows the candidates interest in the insurance sector and the policies laid by the government. This section does not require the candidates to have a deep knowledge of the subject, but it requires the candidates to answer the perception-based question.

There are three stages of exam in the LIC AAO recruitment process. The pattern of each stage of LIC AAO exam is different. The LIC AAO prelims exam is the first stage. There is no negative marking in the LIC AAO exam. Till 2016, there was negative marking in LIC AAO main exam.

LIC AAO Prelims Exam Pattern

LIC AAO prelims exam is conducted online at various centres across the nation. The LIC AAO Prelims has three sections and the total allotted time is 1 hour. The medium of exam will be English and Hindi. The time duration for each section is 20 minutes. The candidates have to score minimum qualifying numbers marked for each section.

After the exam, the authority will decide the cut-off marks for the LIC Prelims exam. LIC AAO prelims marks will not be counted for the final merit. English Language Test will be of qualifying nature and the marks obtained will not be counted for ranking.

LIC AAO Main Exam

LIC AAO main exam is conducted online to select the candidates for the interview stage. The [LIC AAO exam](#) is conducted for the various functionally distinct positions and hence the main exam has a different pattern for each post. The medium of exam will be English and Hindi for all sections except the English section. There will be 30 questions for each section except the descriptive test.

The LIC AAO main exam consists of two types of questions

- Objective test - 300 marks
- Descriptive type - 25 marks

Descriptive paper of only those candidates will be evaluated who qualify in the objective part of the main examination. The English Language Test is of qualifying nature and marks obtained in it will not be counted for the final merit. The pattern of LIC AAO exam is given separately for all the positions:

LIC AAO Interview

LIC AAO Interview is the last stage of the selection process. The number of candidates to be called for interview will be about three times the number of vacancies to be filled.

After the interview, the final result will be declared and the candidates will be sent for the medical test.

How normalisation of marks is done in LIC AAO?



Normalisation is a process undertaken to provide a level playing field to all the candidates appeared in different slots and different question papers. The scores of the examination are obtained by adopting the following procedure:

- (i) The number of questions answered correctly by a candidate in each objective test is considered for arriving at the Score.
- (ii) The score so obtained by a candidate are made equivalent to take care of the minor difference in difficulty level, if any, in each of the objective tests held in different sessions to arrive at the Equated Scores*

* Scores obtained by candidates on any test are equated to the base form by considering the distribution of scores of all the forms.

- (iii) Test wise scores and scores on total are reported with the decimal point up to two digits.
