## What is SSC CPO 2020 exam?

Staff Selection Commission (SSC) conducts an open competitive computer-based exam to select candidates for Sub-Inspector (SI) in Delhi Police, Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) and Assistant Sub-Inspector (ASI) in CISF. Departmental candidates among Constable, Head Constables and Assistant Sub-Inspector in Delhi Police with a minimum three years in service can also apply for the exam. The age of such candidates should not be more than 30 years (33 years for OBC and 35 years for SC/ST). The details of the posts and salary structure are given below:

**Age Limit:** The age of candidates should be between 20 to 25 years. Relaxation in the upper age limit of 5 years is provided to SC/ST candidates and 3 years to OBC and Ex-Servicemen categories.

**Educational Qualification:** Any graduate candidates can apply for SSC SI exam.

## SSC CPO Selection Process 2020

The complete selection process of SSC CPO is explained below:



SSC CPO result which is also part of the selection process is announced online for various stages in PDF form. The marks of candidates are released a few days after the declaration of result. Final selection and allocation to the Post will be made based on the performance in Paper 1, 2 and preferences given by candidates at the time of document verification.

## SSC CPO Exam Analysis

SSC CPO 2020 exam analysis will be made available after the exam is conducted. Till then, candidates can go through the SSC CPO 2019 exam analysis. This will help candidates to know the difficulty level of the exam. The overall paper of SSC CPO 2019 Paper 1 was moderate. The English Language section was easy to moderate while the Quantitative Aptitude section was moderate to difficult. The General Intelligence and Reasoning section was easy to moderate. ## SSC CPO 2020 Exam Centres

SSC CPO 2020 exam is conducted in over 100 cities. The preferences of exam cities are required to be entered while filling the application form. Candidates can choose three cities in the order of their preferences. The examination authority reserves the right to allot the exam cities to candidates. ## SSC CPO 2020 Exam Day Guidelines

- Carry the admit card to the exam hall
- Must reach the exam centre before the reporting time
- Carry passport-sized photographs

- No eatables are allowed in the exam hall.
- No electronic items are allowed in the exam hall.
- Do not wear rings, bracelets, earrings, chains, nose pins, pendant, badge, brooch, hairpin, hair band, clothes with full sleeves.
- Candidates should wear chappal instead of shoes.
- No books/notepads/registers/magazines are allowed in the exam hall.

## SSC CPO 2020 FAQs

**Q. Is SSC CPO exam conducted every year?**

A. Yes, it is conducted every year.

**Q. How can I apply for SSC CPO?**

A. Candidates can apply for the exam online.

**Q. When will I get my admit card?**

A. The admit card is released online two weeks before the exam.

**Q. Will there be any Interview?**

A. No, there will be no interview.

**Q. What is SSC CPO job?**

A. When candidates are selected through SSC CPO exam, they will be appointed as a Sub Inspector with either the Delhi Police, the CAPF or as Assistant Sub Inspector in CISF.

**Q. Does graduation matters in SSC CPO?**

A. Only graduate candidates are eligible to apply for the exam.

**Q. Is SSC CPO a good job?**

A. The documentation and supervision are regarded as a highly respectable job among the public.

**Q. What is the CPO exam?**

A. SSC CPO exam is conducted to recruit candidates to the post of Sub-Inspector (SI) in Delhi Police, Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) and Assistant Sub-Inspector (ASI) in CISF.

**Q. What is the exam pattern of SSC CPO?**

A. [SSC CPO exam pattern](#) is such that it comprises Paper-I, Physical Standard Test (PST)/ Physical Endurance Test (PET), Paper-II and Detailed Medical Examination (DME). Questions in Paper 1 and 2 are objective type. The Paper 1 exam comprises questions from four sections while Paper 2 consists of one section. The duration of both papers is 2 hours.

**Q. What is the syllabus for Paper 1?**

A. [SSC CPO syllabus](#) for Paper 1 comprises topics from General Intelligence and Reasoning, General Knowledge and General Awareness, Quantitative Aptitude and English Comprehension.

**Q. What is the syllabus for Paper 2?**

A. The syllabus for Paper 2 comprises questions from error recognition, filling in the blanks (using verbs, preposition, articles, etc), Vocabulary, Spellings, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms, Sentence Completion, Phrases and Idiomatic use of Words, comprehension, etc.

**Q. What comprises the PET/PST?**

A. PET/PST comprises long jump, high jump, shot put, race, etc.

**Staff Selection Commission (SSC) has delayed the release of SSC CPO 2020 notification.** Earlier, the notification along with the application form was scheduled to be released on April 17. The last date to apply for the exam was May 16. However, it has been delayed due to the outbreak of COVID-19. The commission has not published any notice regarding the delay in the recruitment process on the official website.

SSC has postponed the ongoing SSC CPO 2018 medical examination with effect from March 23, 2020, as a precautionary measure against COVID-19. The fresh schedule of medical examination of remaining candidates will be announced in due course of time. SSC CPO 2019-20 dates were announced along with the notification on September 17, 2019. The application form was available from September 17 to October 16, 2019. The paper 1 exam of **SSC CPO** was conducted from December 9 to 13, 2019. The Paper 2 exam will be conducted on June 21. SSC CPO dates are provided on this page, candidates can check the same to keep themselves updated regarding the important events like the release of application form, release of admit card and announcement of result, etc.

#### Important events related to SSC CPO Dates 2020

The important events related to SSC CPO dates are explained below in details-

**SSC CPO Application Form 2020** - The application form of CPO is released online on the official website. [SSC CPO application form](#) can be filled in two parts: Part 1 (Registration) and Part 2 (Filling detailed application form). The application fee is Rs 200 and SC, ST, Women and ESM candidates are exempted from fee payment.

**SSC CPO Admit Card 2020**- The facility to download SSC CPO admit card is made available on the respective regional websites of the commission at least two weeks before the exam. To download [SSC CPO admit card](#), candidates need to enter registration number or roll number and date of birth.

**SSC CPO Answer Key 2020** - The commission releases the tentative answer key a few days after the completion of test. Candidates can go through [SSC CPO answer keys](#) and submit representations if any within the time frame specified by SSC. To submit challenges, candidates need to pay Rs 100 per question. The answer keys will be scrutinised before publishing the final keys.

**SSC CPO Result 2020** - The result is announced online on the official website. [SSC CPO result](#) is made available in the PDF format in the form of a merit list. On the basis of the performance in Paper 1, candidates are shortlisted for PET/PST. The PET/ PST is mandatory but qualifying in nature. Only those candidates are allowed to appear in Paper 2 who qualify the PET/PST. On the basis of the performance in Paper 1 and 2, candidates are shortlisted for appearing in medical examination. Successful candidates in medical exam are called for document verification.

Before proceeding with the one-time registration, candidates must keep the following documents ready.

## How to fill SSC CPO application form?

Candidates follow the steps below to fill the application form of [SSC CPO](#).

### Part I: One-Time Registration

Visit the official website

Read the instructions carefully before registering for the exam

Candidates who are already registered with SSC are not required to register again.

They can use their generated registration number and password for filling the application form directly.

For the one-time registration, click on 'Register Now' link

For one-time registration process, candidates need to fill the following details:

### Basic Details:

- Few critical details such as Aadhaar Number, name, father's name, mother's name, date of birth etc are required to be entered twice.
- Provide information about Aadhaar Number/Aadhaar Enrollment Number/ Identity Card and its number.
- Candidates need to fill their name, mother's name, father's name, date of birth as given in the Class 10 certificate.
- Fill Class 10 exam details such as name of education board, roll number and year of passing.
- Enter gender, educational qualification, mobile number and email ID.
- Once the basic details are saved, candidates need to confirm their mobile number and email ID.
- Upon confirmation, registration ID and password will be provided to candidates on their mobile number and email ID.
- Proceed to fill the 'Additional Details'



**Additional Details:**

Fill in the details such as category, nationality, Identification Mark, information about disabilities if any. Save the information and proceed further to provide contact details.

**Contact Details:**

Candidates must provide information about permanent and present address. Save the data and proceed further to last part of the registration process.

**Photo Signature and LTI:**

Upload your recent photo, signature, disability certificate if any, Aadhaar Number or Aadhaar Enrolment Number. If you do not have Aadhaar Number or Aadhaar Enrolment Number, then upload the scanned impression of Left Hand Thumb. In case a candidate does not have left hand thumb, impression of right hand thumb or Left great toe or right great toe may be used in that order.

The specifications for uploading these documents are given below:

- The colour passport size photograph should be in JPEG format in between 20KB to 50KB.
- Scanned signature should in JPEG format and between 10KB to 20KB.
- The Left Thumb Impression should be in JPEG format between 10KB to 30KB.
- The Disability Certificate should be in JPEG/PDF format in between 20KB to 50KB.

Save the information provided. Candidates have the facility to take draft printout.

Send the draft information to your registered email ID.

Review the information provided thoroughly, before final submit.

Upon clicking final submit, different OTPs will be sent to the registered mobile number and email ID.

Candidates need to enter the respective OTPs to complete the registration process.

After submission of basic information, if the registration process is not completed within seven days, the data will be deleted from the system.

After completion of registration process, basic details can be changed only once.

**Part II: Online Application Form**

- Login to online system through registered email ID and password.
- Click the 'Apply' link under latest notifications tab.
- Information filled during the one-time registration will be auto filled and is non-editable.
- Give preferences for SSC CPO exam centres. Candidates can choose the examination centres within the same region. They can choose three centers in order of preference.
- If you are ex-serviceman, fill up the required information. Wards of servicemen/ex-servicemen are not treated as ex-servicemen.
- If you are seeking age relaxation, select appropriate age-relaxation category.
- Select your Domicile State/UT and District.
- Candidates need to give their preferences.
- Indicate the highest qualification.
- Information regarding photo, signature, biometric impression will be filled up automatically from the One-Time Registration Data.
- Complete the declaration by clicking 'I Agree' check box, fill up captcha code.
- Preview and verify the information and submit the application.
- If candidates are not exempted from fee payment, they need to pay the same through online mode or through SBI Challan. In case, fee is paid through challan, it will get updated within two to three days.
- Take printout of SSC CPO application form.
- Candidates are not required to submit the hard copy of the application form

A. The application form can be filled online on the official website.

**Q. Can I fill the application form offline?**

A. No, the application form should be filled online only.

**Q. What if I do not have Aadhaar Card/ Aadhaar Enrollment Number?**

- Driving License
- School/ College ID
- Employer ID (Govt./ PSU/ Private)

**Q. How can I login to fill the application form?**

A. Candidates can login with the registration number and password to fill the application form.

**Q. Will I get the registration number and password on my mobile number?**

A. Yes, you will get the registration number and password on the registered mobile number.

**Q. After completion of registration process, can I change the basic details part?**

A. After completion of registration process, the basic details can be changed only once.

**Q. I have already registered, do I need to register again?**

A. No, you do not need to register again.

**Q. What documents do I need to keep after final submission of application?**

A. Candidates need to keep the following documents ready after submission of application.

- Printout of application form
- Copy of identical photographs
- Fee receipt

**Q. How many days it takes to be updated if the fee is paid through challan?**

A. If the fee is paid through challan, it gets two to three days to get updated.

## SSC CPO Exam Pattern for Paper 1

All candidates who registers successfully for the exam are required to appear in the Paper 1. The exam comprises four sections: General Intelligence and Reasoning, General Knowledge and General Awareness, Quantitative Aptitude and English Comprehension. Each section will have 50 questions. The paper will have total 200 objective type questions. The test paper will be set in Hindi and English. The duration of the test is 2 hours. Each section of Paper 1 will carry 50 marks. Total marks of the test is 200. Candidates can check the detailed SSC CPO exam pattern for Paper 1.

## SSC CPO Exam Pattern for Paper 2

This paper comprises objective type questions from English Language and Comprehension. There will be 200 questions in the paper. Candidates need to complete the paper within 2 hours. Questions are designed to test the candidates' understanding and knowledge of English Language.

## SSC CPO Exam Pattern 2020: Marking Scheme

- There is negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer in Paper 1 and 2.
- For the correct answer, candidates will score 1 mark.
- Marks scored by candidates will be normalised to prepare the result

## Normalisation of Marks

Marks scored in Computer Based Examination will be normalised. Such normalised scores will be used to determine the final merit and cut off marks. Normalisation is done since the exam is conducted in multi-shifts and to take into account any variation in the difficulty levels of question papers across different shifts. [Read More](#)

### Medical Exam

Medical exam is conducted for candidates who qualify the Paper 2 exam and found medically fit. Candidates are examined by the medical officer of the CAPF or any other Medical Officer or Assistant Surgeon belonging to Grade I of any Central/State Govt. Hospital or Dispensary.

**Eye sight:** The minimum near vision should be N6 (better eye) and N9 (worse eye). The minimum distant vision should be 6/6 (better eye) and 6/9 (worse eye) of both

eyes without any correction like wearing glasses or surgery of any kind to improve visual acuity.

Candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision.

Finally selected candidates for the posts of Sub-Inspector and Assistant Sub-Inspector as a part of the training curriculum have to pass seven obstacles:

- Jumping over the Vertical Board
- Holding the rope on jumping from the Board
- Tarzan Swing
- Jumping on the Horizontal Board
- Parallel Rope
- Monkey Crawl
- Vertical Rope

## Results

SSC CPO marks for Paper 1 has been released on February 27, 2020. Candidates can check their individual marks by using registration number or roll number and password. The facility to check the marks is available till March 28, 2020.

Earlier, SSC CPO result 2019 for Paper 1 was announced on February 14, 2020. A total of 46,436 candidates have qualified the exam. The result is available in PDF form. The result is released separately for male and female candidates. The merit list displays the roll numbers of qualified candidates. ## SSC CPO 2019 Marksheet

The marksheet is released a few days after the declaration of SSC CPO result. The marksheet will be available in PDF format. It will display candidate's name, roll number, category, gender and marks.

## SSC CPO Result 2019 – Calculation of Scores

- For each correct answer, candidates will get 1 mark.



- For the wrong answer, 0.25 marks will be deducted as penalty.
- The score of candidates is calculated based on the number of correct and incorrect responses.
- The normalisation process is followed to calculate the scores.

## What is normalisation of marks?

The normalisation of scores is done since the exam is conducted in multiple shifts in order to take into account any variation in the difficulty levels of question papers across different shifts. Calculation of marks is done up to five decimal places. Normalisation is done through the following formula:

### SSC CPO Result 2019 Paper 1

Paper 1 comprises questions from General Intelligence and Reasoning, General Knowledge and General Awareness, Quantitative Aptitude and English Comprehension. The test carries a total 200 marks. Candidates qualifying the exam will be called for PET/PST.

### SSC CPO Result 2019 PET/PST

The PET/PST is conducted for the qualified candidates of Paper 1. In this test, candidates are judged based on their fitness. This is qualifying in nature, however, candidates need to qualify the exam.

### SSC CPO Result 2019 Paper 2

The paper 2 is conducted for the qualified candidates of PET/PST. The test comprises English language & Comprehension. Total marks of the test are 200. Candidates qualifying the exam are called for Detailed Medical Examination.

### SSC CPO Final Result 2019

The final result is declared based on Paper 1 and 2 marks provided candidates qualify the document verification and medical examination. The final result will mention the roll numbers, names, gender, category, posts allotted and ranks of candidates. Based on the final result, candidates are offered appointments.

### SSC CPO 2019 Minimum Qualifying Marks

## Vacancies

Selection of candidates against SSC CPO vacancies is done based on Paper 1, Physical Standard Test (PST)/ Physical Endurance Test (PET), Paper 2 and Detailed Medical Examination (DME). Selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in India.

## SSC CPO Selection Process

The stages of SSC CPO recruitment process are explained below:

**Paper 1:** This paper is conducted for all registered candidates. On the basis of their performance in Paper-I, candidates will be shortlisted for appearing in PET/ PST Examination. The commission will fix qualifying marks in Paper 1 to select candidates for the next round of selection process.

**PET/PST:** PET/ PST is mandatory but qualifying in nature. Ex-Servicemen are not required to undergo PET.

**Paper 2:** Only those candidates who qualify PET/ PST are allowed to appear in the Paper 2 exam.

**Medical Exam and Document Verification:** On the basis of candidates' performance in Paper 1 and Paper 2, they will be shortlisted for appearing in medical examination. Candidates, who are successful in medical examination, will be called for detailed Document Verification.

**Final Selection:** Final selection and allocation will be made on the basis of the performance of candidates in Paper 1 and Paper 2 and the preferences of posts/force given by them at the time of document verification.
