## What is SSC MTS?

SSC MTS or Staff Selection Commission-Multi Tasking (Non-Technical) Staff Examination is a national level exam conducted by SSC for recruitment of candidates in General Central Service Group-C non-gazetted, non-ministerial posts in various ministries, departments and offices of Government of India. Candidates recruited as multi-tasking staff by Staff Selection Commission (SSC) fall in Pay Band-1 (Rs 5,200-20,200) + Grade Pay Rs 1,800.

## SSC MTS Eligibility 2020

Basic criteria that candidates need to fulfill in order to meet SSC MTS eligibility 2020 are:

- A candidate must be either/or a citizen of India, subject of Nepal/Bhutan, Tibetan refugee, person of Indian origin
- Candidates should be aged between 18 and 27 years as on August 1, 2020
- Candidates should clear class X from a recognised board

## SSC MTS Selection Process 2020

SSC MTS selection process includes the following steps:

### Step 1: Fill SSC MTS application form

Firstly, candidates need to fill SSC MTS 2020 application form on the official website of the commission. Candidates also need to pay Rs 100 as application fee in online mode.

### Step 2: Download SSC MTS admit card

Candidates can download their SSC MTS admit card 2020 from the regional websites of the commission. The admit card for SSC MTS exam contains all important details about the candidate (such as name, roll number, category) and the exam (such as exam centre name, address).

### Step 3: Appear for SSC MTS Paper-I

SSC MTS paper-I is a computer-based exam of 90 minutes duration. Questions in the exam are mainly asked from subjects such as English, Reasoning, Numerical Aptitude and General Awareness.

### Step 4: Appear for SSC MTS Paper-II

Candidates clearing paper-I need to appear for SSC MTS paper-II. The paper-II of SSC MTS exam is a descriptive test of 30 minutes duration. In this paper, candidates need to write a short essay or letter in English or any other regional language. This paper is only qualifying in nature.

### Step 5: Check SSC MTS result

Once both the papers are over, Staff Selection Commission will release the final SSC MTS result on its official website. Candidates qualifying the exam will have to appear for the document verification round.

### Step 6: Appear for SSC MTS document verification round

Finally, all qualifying candidates need to appear for the document verification round along with all original documents prescribed by the commission. All candidates whose document verification gets successfully complete will then be allotted services as per the available vacancies.

## SSC MTS FAQs

### Q: Is SSC MTS conducted in offline mode?

A: Paper-I of SSC MTS is conducted in online mode as a computer-based test. Paper-II of SSC MTS is conducted offline as a pen-and-paper based test.

### Q: For which posts is SSC MTS conducted?

A: The SSC MTS exam is conducted for Group-C non-gazetted, non-ministerial posts in various ministries and offices of Government of India.

### Q: What is the application fee for SSC MTS exam?

A: The application fee for SSC MTS exam is Rs 100. However, candidates belonging to reserved categories and females of all categories are exempted from paying the application fee.

### Q: What is the minimum eligibility for SSC MTS exam?

A: Candidates need to be class X pass in order to be eligible for SSC MTS exam.

### Q: How many times is SSC MTS held in a year?

A: The SSC MTS exam is conducted once a year by Staff Selection Commission.

**SSC MTS application form 2020** along with the notification will be released by Staff Selection Commission (SSC) on **June 2**. Candidates can apply online for SSC MTS exam on the official website of the commission.

Every year, about 20 lakh candidates appear for SSC MTS exam. In 2019, total 38.58 lakh candidates registered while 19.18 lakh aspirants appeared for the exam.

Candidates can apply for SSC MTS in two parts – one-time registration and application. Candidates can follow the below-mentioned steps to fill the application form for Staff Selection Commission-Multi Tasking Staff (SSC MTS) exam:

### Part-I: SSC MTS Registration

Before commencing with the application process, candidates need to register themselves on the official website of the commission. For the same, candidates can follow the steps mentioned below:

- Click on the Register Now link
- Fill all details asked in the registration form such as:

## SSC MTS Application FAQs

### Q: When will SSC MTS 2020 application form be released?

A: SSC MTS application form will be released on June 2, 2020.

### Q: Can I apply for SSC MTS exam in offline mode?

A: No, you can apply for the exam in online mode only on the official website of the commission.

### Q: Can I edit the SSC MTS application form after final submission?

A: No, you would not be able to edit the application form after the final submission. Therefore, it is recommended to fill the SSC MTS application form very carefully.

### Q: Is the application fee for SSC MTS exam refundable?

A: No, SSC MTS application fee once paid is non-refundable.

### Q: Is Aadhaar card mandatory to apply for SSC MTS exam?

A: No, you can provide the details of any ID proof at the time of filling the application form.

Staff Selection Commission-Multi Tasking Staff (SSC MTS) exam is conducted for two papers – I and II. SSC MTS paper-I is an objective test conducted in online mode. SSC MTS paper-II is a descriptive test conducted in offline mode.

### SSC MTS Pattern for Paper-I

SSC MTS Paper-I is divided into four parts containing total 100 objective-type Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs) of 100 marks. Candidates need to complete the paper in online mode in a duration of one and a half hours (90 minutes). For further clarification, candidates can refer the table below:

**SSC MTS Marking Scheme for Paper-I:** One mark is allotted for every correct answer in the exam. 0.25 marks are deducted for every incorrect answer in the exam.

### SSC MTS Pattern for Paper-II

SSC MTS Paper-II is a descriptive test conducted in offline mode as a pen-and-paper based test. In paper-II, candidates have to write a short essay or letter on a given topic in a maximum duration of half an hour (30 minutes). Candidates can write the essay/letter in English/Hindi or any other regional language included in the eighth schedule of the Constitution of India.

**SSC MTS Marking Scheme for Paper-II:** There is no negative marking in paper-II of SSC MTS exam.

It may be noted that SSC MTS Paper-II is qualifying in nature. That means that marks scored by candidates in this paper are not considered at the time of preparation of SSC MTS merit list. As per the official notification, "The exam is intended to test elementary language skills in view of



categorisation of the post as Group-C and in view of job requirements.”

## Syllabus

SSC MTS syllabus 2020 will be released by [Staff Selection Commission \(SSC\)](#) along with the release of the notification on June 2. The [SSC MTS exam](#) is conducted for two papers – paper-I (computer-based exam) and paper-II (descriptive test). SSC MTS syllabus for both the papers remain largely the same every year. Therefore, given below is complete last year’s SSC MTS syllabus for both paper-I and -II. However, before we proceed with elaborating on the syllabus, let us have a quick look at the SSC MTS exam pattern.

### SSC MTS Paper-I Syllabus for General Awareness

Similar to English and Numerical Aptitude sections, questions asked in General Awareness are also of Class 10 level. The questions are designed to test a candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions are also designed to test a candidate's knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects. The section will include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries pertaining to the following:

Sports	History
Culture	Geography
Economic Scene	General Polity including Indian Constitution, and Scientific Research etc.

### SSC MTS Syllabus for Paper-II

SSC MTS paper-II is a descriptive test in which candidates have to write a short essay or letter. The test aims to test a candidate's basic language skills commensurate with the educational qualification prescribed for the post. The test is set in English, Hindi and other prescribed regional languages.

## Admit Card

**SSC MTS admit card 2020** will be released by Staff Selection Commission (SSC) about **one week before** the conduct of the exam. The admit card will be released region-wise on the official regional and sub-regional websites of the commission. ## Important points regarding SSC MTS Admit Card

## SSC MTS Result Declaration Process

SSC MTS result is declared after each stage of the exam is over as explained below:

### SSC MTS paper-I result

Candidates who successfully fill the [SSC MTS application form](#) and pay the exam fee appear for paper-I of the exam. The normalised scores of the candidates are used to determine the merit in paper-I.

### SSC MTS paper-II result

Candidates qualifying paper-I then appear for paper-II. [SSC MTS](#) paper-II is only qualifying in nature. The minimum percentage that candidates need to obtain to clear the test are 40 per cent for unreserved category and 35 per cent for all reserved category candidates.

It may be noted that in case normalised marks scored by two or more candidates are equal, the marks scored by them in paper-II are taken into consideration to determine the final SSC MTS merit list.

### SSC MTS document verification

Based on their performance in paper-I and -II, candidates are shortlisted to appear for document verification process. Candidates whose documents are found in order are considered for final selection.

Some of the documents that candidates need to carry for the document verification round are:

Two passport-size recent photographs	One original photo ID proof [Aadhaar Card/Voter ID Card/PAN Card/Passport/Driving License/Government School or College ID Card/Employer ID (Govt/PSU)]

## Final SSC MTS result

Final selection of candidates is done based on the following parameters:

- Marks scored in paper-I
- Preference of states/UTs given by candidates in SSC MTS application form
- Age-group of the candidates

## SSC MTS Result: Tie-Break

In case, one or more candidates score equal aggregate marks tie is resolved as per the below-mentioned criteria:

- A candidate who scores more marks in paper-II is given preference
- If the tie is not resolved, a candidate who is older in age is given preference
- In case the tie is still not resolved, the alphabetical order of candidates' names is considered
