## What is SSC Stenographer 2020 exam?

Staff Selection Commission (SSC) conducts SSC Stenographer exam every year for recruitment of Stenographer Grade C (Group B Non-Gazetted) and Grade D (Group C) for various Ministries/ Departments/ Organisations.

## SSC Stenographer 2020 Eligibility Criteria

Candidates need to fulfill the following eligibility criteria:

### Nationality

Candidates must be either:

(I) Citizen of India or

(II) A subject of Nepal or

(III) Citizen of Bhutan or

(IV) Tibetan refugee who came to India before January 1, 1962, with the intention of settling in India or

(V) Indian origin person who has migrated from Pakistan, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (Formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.

Provided that a candidate belonging to categories II, III, IV and V in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Indian Government.

## Selection Process of SSC Stenographer

The complete selection process of SSC Stenographer comprises the following two stages:

**Release of application form:** [SSC Stenographer application form](#) is released online. The application fee is Rs 100, Women and Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Persons with disability (PWD) and Ex-servicemen (ESM) candidates are exempted from fee payment.

**Issue of admit card:** [SSC Stenographer admit card](#) is released online on the respective regional websites of the commission. Candidates can access their admit cards by logging with registration ID/roll number/candidate's name and password.

**Computer Based Test:** This is the first stage of SSC Stenographer Grade C & D. The computer-based test is conducted for all candidates who successfully register for the exam. The exam comprises three sections, General Intelligence & Reasoning, General Awareness, and English Language and Comprehension. The total marks for the test are 200.

**Declaration of result:** [SSC Stenographer result](#) will be declared online for different stages of exams. The result will be available in PDF format. It will display the roll numbers of qualified candidates. Along with the result, [SSC Stenographer cut off marks](#) for various posts and categories are also released.

**Skill Test in Stenography-** This stage is conducted for the shortlisted candidates of the Computer Based Test. Candidates will be given one dictation for 10 minutes in English or Hindi. Candidates need to type the dictation at the speed of 100 words per minute for the post of Stenographer Grade C and 80 w.p.m for the post of Grade D.

## SSC Stenographer 2020 Exam Centres

The list of exam centres was released by SSC along with the notification. Candidates had to enter their choices of exam centres while filling SSC Stenographer application form. ## Important Instructions for the exam

- Candidates need to carry Aadhaar Card, Passport, Driving License, PAN Card, Voter's ID Card along with the admit card
- Electronic items like mobile phones, calculator, pagers, etc are not allowed inside the exam centre
- Candidates are advised to reach the exam centre one hour early to complete the verification process
- Candidates will not be allowed to leave the exam hall till the completion of test

## SSC Stenographer Grade C & D 2020 FAQs

**Q. Is SSC Stenographer Grade C & D exam conducted every year?**

A. Yes, SSC conducts SSC Stenographer exam every year.

**Q. What is the work of SSC Stenographer?**

A. The job responsibility of SSC Stenographer in various ministries or departments is speech writing, press conference briefings, helping in public relation, etc.

**Q. How to fill the SSC Stenographer application form 2020?**



A. The application form has to be filled online. The steps include - registration, uploading of the image, filling the detailed application form and fee payment.

**Q. What are the application fees?**

A. For General/ OBC/ EWS candidates, the application fee is Rs 100. The application fee is exempted for SC/ ST/ Pwd/ Ex-servicemen and Female candidates.

**Q. When the admit card is released?**

A. SSC Stenographer admit card is released two weeks before the exam. The admit card will be available online on the official website. Candidates can download SSC Stenographer 2019 admit card by logging with the required credentials.

**Q. Can I change SSC Stenographer exam centres?**

A. The exam centres cannot be changed after final submission of the application form.

**Q. What is the exam pattern of SSC Stenographer?**

A. The computer-based test as per [SSC Stenographer exam pattern](#) comprises three sections - General English and Intelligence, General Awareness and English Language and Comprehension. The test paper comprises 200 objective type questions which candidates need to complete within 2 hours. The test carries a total 200 marks.

**Q. Are there any negative marks in the exam?**

A. Yes, there are negative marks in the exam. For each wrong answer, 0.25 marks will be deducted.

**Q. What is the standard of the syllabus?**

A. [SSC Stenographer syllabus](#) comprises the topics that candidates have studied in their class 10 and 12 standards.

**Q. Is there any interview for SSC Stenographer exam?**

A. Candidates qualifying the computer-based test are called for the skill test in stenography. Those who qualify the skill test are called for document verification.

**Q. Is it mandatory to appear in skill test?**

A. Yes, it is mandatory to appear in skill test.

**Important events related to SSC Stenographer**

The important events of SSC Stenographer are explained below:

**Filling of application form:** [SSC Stenographer application form](#) was released on September 20, 2019. Candidates could fill the application form online till October 18, 2019. Online fee payment could be done till October 20, 2020. Candidates could pay their fees offline till October 22 provided the challan was generated before October 20.

**Release of admit card:** [SSC Stenographer admit card](#) is released three weeks before the exam. Registered candidates can download the admit card from the sub-regional websites of the commission. To download the admit card, candidates need to enter the required credentials. The hard copy of the admit card is not sent to candidates by post.

**Entrance exam:** The computer-based test of SSC Stenographer comprises three sections: General Intelligence & Reasoning, General Awareness, and English Language and Comprehension. The test paper will have total of 200 objective type questions. The total marks allotted to the test are 200. The duration of the test is 2 Hours. There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer. Marks scored by candidates will be normalised to determine the merit list and cutoff marks. On the basis of the marks of the computer-based tests, candidates will be shortlisted for the Skill Test. Skill Test is mandatory but qualifying in nature. Final selection and allocation of Ministries/ Departments will be made on the basis of the performance of candidates in the computer-based test and the preference of posts given by them at the time of Document Verification.

**Declaration of result:** The result is announced online on the official website separately for different stages of recruitment. [SSC Stenographer result](#) will



be available in PDF in the form of a merit list. The scores of both qualified and non-qualified candidates are made available a few days after the declaration of result. Candidates can download the scorecard by logging with the required credentials.

## How to fill SSC Stenographer Application Form 2020?

The application form of SSC Stenographer is available on the official website of [SSC](#). The process of filling online application form consists of two parts – one-time registration and fill online application for the exam. Candidates need to follow the steps below to fill the application form.

### Part I – One-Time Registration

- For one-time registration, candidates need to click on 'Register Now' provided in the login section
- While registering, candidates need to enter basic details, additional details & contact details and upload scanned images of photograph and signature
- Candidates need to provide information regarding Aadhaar Number/Identity Card number
- Candidates have to enter name, father's name, mother's name, date of birth, details of Class 10 exam, level of highest educational qualification
- Provide mobile number, email ID, address
- When the basic details are saved, candidates are required to confirm their mobile number and email ID
- On confirmation, registration number and password will be generated. The same will be sent to candidate's registered mobile number and email ID
- Candidates need to login to fill other details like category, nationality, etc
- Upload the scanned images of photograph and signature
- Upon clicking 'Final Submit' different OTPs will be sent to candidates registered mobile number
- Candidates need to enter the OTPs at the required field to complete the registration process
- Read the declaration carefully and click 'I Agree' button

### Part II – Filling online application form

- Candidates need to login with registration number and password
- Click 'Apply' link in 'Stenographer Grade 'C' & 'D' Examination 2020' section under the latest notifications tab
- Candidates need to provide details of exam centres. They need to send preferences of three centres in the order of preference



- Select medium of test – English or Hindi
- Candidates need to select the post
- After entering details, candidates need to click on 'I Agree' check box
- Candidates need to proceed to pay the application fees
- The application fee is Rs 100 (Women, SC, ST, PWD, Ex-Servicemen candidates are exempted from fee payment). The fee can be paid using BHIM UPI, Net Banking or by using Visa, Mastercard, Maestro, RuPay Credit or Debit card or in cash
- When the application is successfully submitted, it will be accepted provisionally
- Candidates should take the printout of the application form for their own record

## SSC Stenographer 2020 Application Form FAQs

### Q. Can I submit offline application for SSC Stenographer exam?

A. Only online applications will be accepted for the recruitment process.

### Q. What if I don't have Aadhaar Card or Aadhaar Enrollment Number?

A. If candidates do not have Aadhaar Number, they can provide details of the following identity card:

- Voter ID Card
- PAN Card
- Passport
- Driving License
- School/College ID
- Employer ID (Govt/PSU/Private)

### Q. Do I need to send the hard copy of the application form?

A. No, candidates are not required to send the hard copy of SSC Stenographer application form.

### Q. What if my application form is not submitted?

A. Candidates need to contact with the examination authority.

### Q. Will I get the registration number and password on my mobile number?

A. Yes, you will get the registration number and password on the registered mobile number.

### Q. After completion of the registration process, can I change the basic details part?

A. After completion of the registration process, the basic details can be changed only once.

### Q. I have already registered, do I need to register again?

A. No, you do not need to register again.

### Q. Is it necessary to keep the fee receipt?

A. Yes, it is necessary to keep the fee receipt.

### Q. How many days it takes to be updated if the fee is paid through challan?

A. If the fee is paid through challan, it gets two to three days to get updated.

### Q. How can I check the application status?

A. You can check the application status by clicking the latest notifications tab under the dashboard.

## SSC Stenographer Exam Pattern 2019-20 for Computer Based Test

The Computer Based Test of SSC Stenographer comprises three sections: General Intelligence & Reasoning, General Awareness and English Language and Comprehension. The General Intelligence & Reasoning and General Awareness sections carry 50 questions each while English Language and Comprehension section comprise 100 questions. Total marks allotted to General Intelligence & Reasoning and General Awareness sections are 50 each while English Language and Comprehension section consists of 100 marks. Candidates will be given 2 hours to complete the exam.

## SSC Stenographer Exam Pattern 2019-20 for Skill Test

Candidates for this stage are shortlisted based on their performance in the skill test. In this test, candidates will be given one dictation for 10 minutes in English or Hindi which they need to type at the speed of 100 words per minute (w.p.m) for the post of Stenographer Grade C and 80 w.p.m for Stenographer Grade D post. Candidates need to type the dictation on the computer. The duration of the test for different posts are given below-
